

Villion Blanc de l'Atlantique 2015

Pale straw in colour. Clear and brilliant

Tasting Notes

Provocative entry with seductive, sweet spiciness and citrus pot-pouri emanating from the dominant Viognier component. Delightful caramel and lime tones from the Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay elements add to the complexity.

Seamless, creamy entry on palate is enhanced with a lively freshness that lingers on your tongue. The spiciness on the nose lingers to fulfilment on the after-taste.

- Elgin Viognier 71%
- Botrivier Chenin Blanc 22%
- Elgin Chardonnay 7%

Production: 3850 bottles of 750 ml

Some components of the wine were lightly wooded in 300- and 400 litre French Oak barrels for three to six months.
