Welcoming array of cassis and blueberries on the entry, layered with paprika spice and sweet, cigar box aromas, drawing the senses to experience a well-balanced Cabernet with a perfectly judged oak contribution.

Mouth-filling intensity, vibrant and firm with a prolonged finish of red berry fruit and enticing sweet spice. Rich, accommodating texture, polished and complete.

Oak Maturation

21 months in French Oak, mostly matured in 300 litre second fill barrels and 25% new oak to emphasize the fruit attribution.
