Tasting Notes

Captivating entry on the nose of aromatic, ripe plum, black cherry and dusted white pepper. Secondary nuances of perfumed violets and caramel tobacco complete this enticing Syrah, showcasing its maritime origin.

Impressive intensity of flavour on the palate, mouth-filling plum and spice, full and textured with fine and polished tannins and a lingering, creamy finish.

Oak Maturation

21 months in French oak, mostly matured in second fill French oak barrels and 30% new oak to emphasize the fruit from these delicate and elegant Syrah sites.
